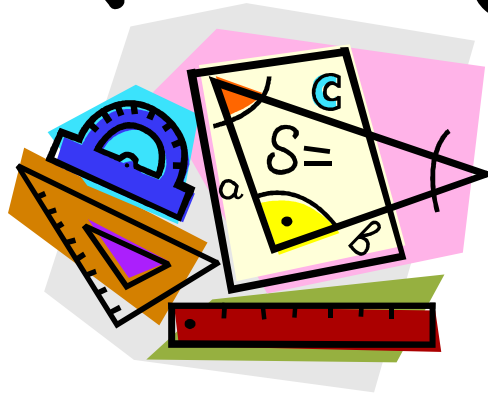


# Welcome
